# beyond empowerment: capacity building for NEET youth, long-term unemployed adults or migrants?

many, many people are falling behind in our rapidly changing globalized world. young NEETs, migrants never really integrated, unemployed adults with little educational background.

traditional job center provisions do not work anymore, if they ever did; new empowerment approaches are positive and well-meaning, but mostly leaves behind people in unchanged situations.

you know this, but you are not sure what to do about it...

you will then enjoy an intensive course designed especially for your needs and interests, in which you will:

- → learn about the situation of those people and how they ended up in very problematic situations
- → discuss why the things we offer them do not work
- → learn about what 21<sup>st</sup> century capacity building might mean and what practice it might lead to
- → engage in discussions about valuable innovate learning principles that might contribute to such capacity building
- → work on examples from your practice and how different ways out might be possible
- → work to re-think what those people needs and how capacity building aims to help those people change their social and economic situation
- ightarrow learn about how you might obtain funding for your experiments from local, national and European programs

## # Let's do some questions and answers #

How are these courses organized?

They can be flexibly organised in your community or in Catalonia, and of course these two very different ways include different economy and preparation.

#### Who will organize this?

If in Catalonia we will take care of the accommodation, meeting facilities and things like that; if in your community then you will do this.

#### Who will pay?

Our way to finance is totally non-profit and transparent.

If in Catalonia you will pay for your own travel and accommodation, if in your community you will pay for our travel and accommodation.

We always use fair-priced accommodation and low-fare flights.

You will need to pay us for the work: the number of course work day + 2 work days for preparation and follow up, based on a standard non-profit rate of 200 euro per day (no matter if one or two Working with Europe professionals are involved).

Example: a 4 day course in your community:  $4 \times 200$  euro (course days) +  $2 \times 200$  euro (preparation and follow-up) = 1200 euro + travel and accommodation - we do not charge you for our travel days.

You might use the European mobility programs to finance your costs if the course is in Catalonia, and you might get local support from your organisation, educational authorities or from other available sources no matter if in your community or in Catalonia.

#### Preparation and follow-up

Yes, indeed. All participants will be invited to a small online forum - BaseCamp - at least 2 weeks prior to the course - for preparation and first dialogues. After the course we will follow-up in the same forum and see where it leads us...

#### Credit

Yes. Working with Europe will issue a participation document to all participants describing the aim and the content of the course.

#### How many per course

Minimum 3 and maximum 10

#### Language

Well, normally in English, but we are used to work with translation along the courses. It is, however, your responsibility to include a possible translator in the course.

#### Program

You will not find a detailed program for the courses. Why not?

Because the detailed program will depend on your needs and interests and on who will participate...

The courses will deliver intensive work days - 9-12 and 13 to 16, unless otherwise agreed. The course preparation will include access to key papers and comprehensive briefings and introductions.

The follow-up will include evaluation, guidance and counseling - and further perspectives. The courses will be prepared and delivered by professionals with 15 years in the frontline of European educational innovation and with experience from numerous European projects and collaborations with the European Commission, its Joint Research Center and EU National Agencies.
