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### # iYouth kicking-off #

Recently granted iYouth is one of the most innovative and challenging projects Working with Europe has created, launched and participated in - and it was kicked-off in November. The mission of the project is to describe and share models for how young students in secondary school can grow a strong and sustainable interest in innovation - through direct engagement in innovation... The project is coordinated by USV Suceava in Romania and includes the interaction with youth teams all along the project duration.



### # sport entrepreneurial capacity building #

The partners in the Erasmus+ sport entrepreneurial project met for a 5 days capacity building in Nagykovácsi near Budapest. Partners and youth workers struggled to go deeper into what sport entrepreneurship might mean for young people and how sport entrepreneurial missions can be designed and implemented. Along the week the participants were invited to get impressions of the local sport entrepreneurship in Nagykovácsi.

### # CHRIS - countering radicalisation #

The extremely challenging CHRIS project started out in Roskilde near Copenhagen. The project is coordinated by University College Zealand DK and is missioned to create innovative approaches to countering radicalisation in school. The project is, of course, of great relevance as radicalisation is expected to be on the rise across the next many years - due to unstable political realities in the US and in the EU.



### # empowerWOMENT and Third Europe #

Two recently granted Erasmus+ projects will be started up along the next months: empowerWOMENT and Third Europe. Third Europe will build entrepreneurial capacity among Third Sector managers to manage emerging sector challenges and is coordinated by the Euclid Network in the UK; empowerWOMENT will help start-up women manage the many challenges linked to new businesses and is coordinated by the Ministry of Family and Social Policies Ankara TR.

### # ScienceGirls kicked-off in North-Western UK #

The most promising ScienceGirls Erasmus+ project was granted summer 2016 - and now kicked-off in the Cumbria region in the UK. The project is coordinated by the Furness Academy and aims to create new approaches for making girls interested in science. Teams of girls are involved across the entire project, as the project invites secondary school girls to co-create the project results.

A strong Working with Europe 2017 Erasmus+ initiative will be We need ACCESS - a project missioned to create access for secondary schools to valuable best practice in the field of early school leaving prevention. The initiative will be created in collaboration with ACTA from Oradea Romania.
